Acts 7:48-50

"Look," he said, "I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

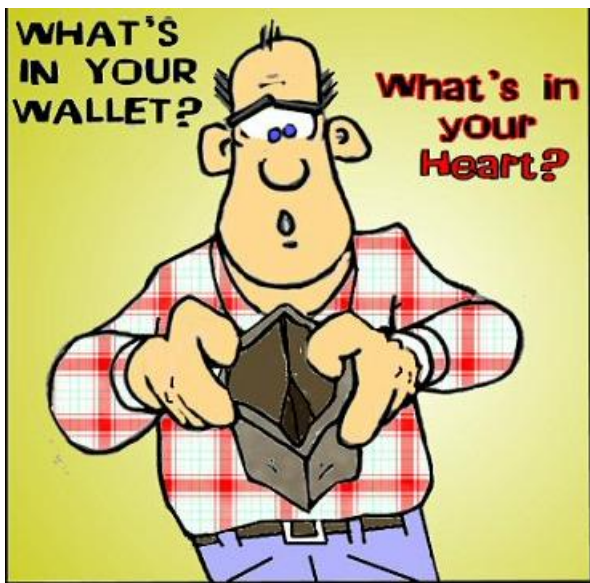
Acts 7:59-60

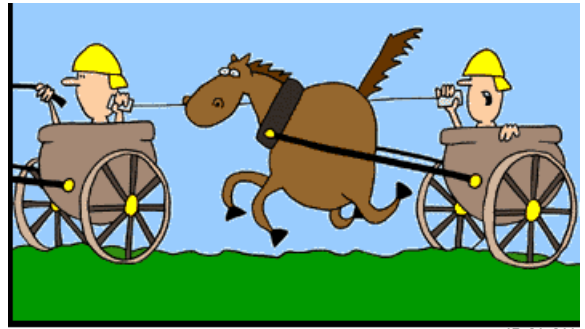

Acts 8:26-39

Philip and the Ethiopian

²⁶ Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, "Go south to the road — the desert road — that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." ²⁷ So he started out, and on his way he met an **Ethiopian** eunuch, an **important official** in charge of all the **treasury** of **Candace**, queen of the **Ethiopians**. This man had gone to Jerusalem to worship, ²⁸ and on his way home was sitting in his chariot reading the book of I saiah the prophet. ²⁹ The Spirit told Philip, "Go to that chariot and stay near it."

³⁰ Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading I saiah the prophet. "Do you understand what you are reading?" Philip asked.

³¹ "How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me?" So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him.

³² The eunuch was reading this **passage** of Scripture:



"He was led like a **sheep** to the **slaughter**, and as a **lamb** before the **shearer** is silent, so he did not open his mouth.

³³ In his humiliation he was deprived of justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth.

³⁴ The eunuch asked Philip, "Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?" ³⁵ Then Philip began with that very **passage** of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus.

³⁶ As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptized?" ³⁸ And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip

baptized him. ³⁹ When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way **rejoicing**.

⁵ "Who are you, Lord?" Saul asked.

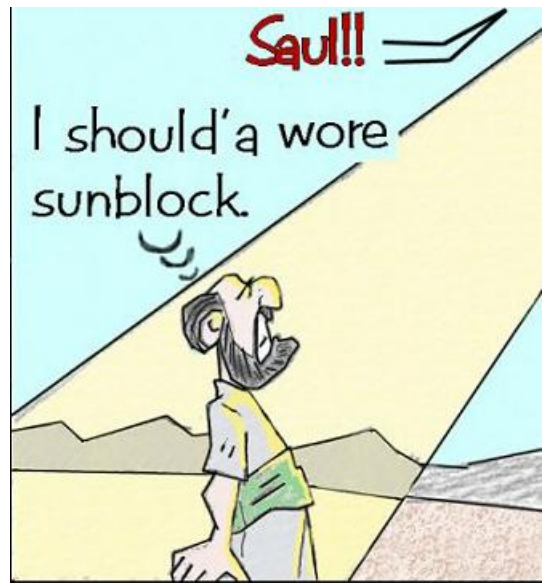
"I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting," he replied. ⁶ "Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do."
