Haitian People

- The population is approximately seven million,
- with a male life expectancy of 47 years,
- the female life expectancy is 51 years.
- The adult illiteracy rate hovers near 90%,
- the average annual income is less than \$400,
- and unemployment rates soar.
- Over 75% of Haiti's population lives in poverty conditions.



It is the poorest country in the world. None of these, however, is the gravest problem Haiti faces. Haiti needs Jesus. We have come to give Haiti the call the Apostle Peter says is for all Christians, the call out of darkness into His wonderful light, the light of His Son.

A History of Spiritual Slavery



In 1801, Toussaint Louverture led the slaves in a revolt against the French colonists. After a bloody three-year war, Haiti became the first black republic in the world. The slaves declared their independence on January 1, 1804, sacrificed a pig, and dedicated the country to Satan.

From its inception, the nation has been consecrated to worshipping evil and its maker.

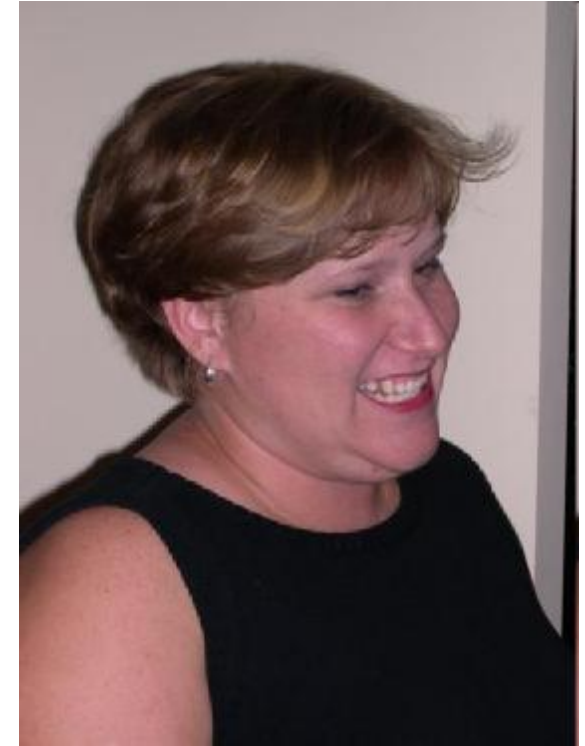
