

In July 2001, the Snyders returned to Kenya to begin our third term serving the Maasai with Christian Missionary Fellowship.

About their Ministry



Time line of Ministry with the Maasai

- 1974 - First survey into Kenya by Ethiopian team.
- 1978 - Brocks & Dotys arrive (January). By year end, Johnsons, Priests, & Hudson are on the field.

- 1980 - Meeting of several hundred Maasai elders: "We believe all these things and want to follow Jesus."
- 1981 - 18 Missionaries, 2 bush clinics.
- 1984 - Disengagement from the African Inland Church. Work opened among the Baraguyu of Tanzania (*cousins of Maasai*).
- 1985 - Famine relief.
- 1986 - First urban thrust into Narok town (*multi-tribal*)
- 1988 - Formal Maasai-wide literacy program begins. Two families join team as CMF work in Tanzania closes.
- 1989 - 2x2 program -- Maasai evangelists do village evangelism. Dedication of the training center in Ewaso Ng'iro. Research done among the Samburu (*cousins of Maasai*).



- 1991 - Dedication of the Narok Church of Christ building.
- 1992 - 38 Missionaries; new work begins in Emurua Dikir; 5 clinics.
- 1994 - Evangelists go into unreached areas of Maasailand (*2x2 program*). Food for work provided (*famine relief*). Dedication of second training center at Ng'atataek.

- 1995 - Narok Church of Christ fully led by Kenyan ministers, elders, deacons, and deaconesses.
- 1996 - 27 missionaries; 61 churches with an average attendance of 2,500; 135 baptisms. Elder training begins in churches.
- 1997 - Transition of leadership seminars help the Maasai churches consolidate and assume more autonomy.
- 1998 - Youth ministry begun in churches.
- 2000 - 8 missionaries; 9 clinics, all Maasai run; church leaders form an advisory council of church leaders and hire a Maasai worker for youth ministries.
- 2001 - Snyders return to Kenya in July



- 2001 - Franklin Christian Church sends missions group to Tanzania and Kenya
- 2002 - Snyders 20th wedding anniversary
- 2002 - Snyders 10th Kenya ministry anniversary
- 2002 - Dave becomes CMF's Field Business Administrator in Kenya

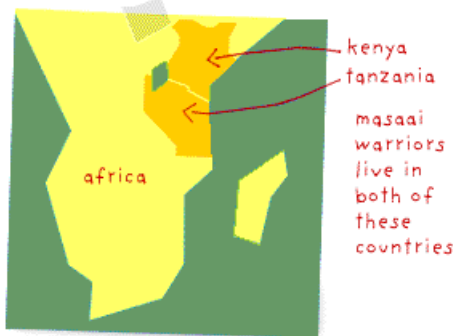

Maasai since January 7, 1992.

They depend on your prayers for an effective ministry as they balance their roles while raising their children, Rebekah (1990) and Lauren (1993).

The Snyders' work combines medicine and ministry to the Maasai through CMF's five bush clinics in Narok District. Suzie oversees patient care, while Dave oversees the churches and literacy workers and manages the ongoing operation of the clinics in their work area. Dave is also the CMF's Field Business Administrator in Kenya - a significant support role for all CMF families serving in Kenya.
