

Santo is serving as the pastor for the church in Madre so we are able to offer more opportunities for the new Christians there to study the Bible.

Work teams from IL, IA, MN and MD have been a huge blessing and encouragement to our mission team this year! We also had Kassie Faber serve as a summer intern.



The Saturday night service for teenagers has grown, and the teens are taking some leadership roles in planning activities.

A combined worship service with the Monte Cristi and Madre churches was a great encouragement to Christians from both churches as well as the work team from MD.

The sports ministry continues to grow, reaching adults, teens and children; men and women; Haitians and Dominicans. We have baseball, softball, soccer, volleyball and basketball.



We now need all three vehicles to transport people from the area by the ballfield on Sundays (and sometimes need an extra trip with one van). We have as many as 70 people attending Tuesday and Thursday evening Bible studies. The people are hungry to hear the Word of God.

## Mission Leader Highlight

Each newsletter we will be highlighting one of our mission leaders. We will begin with Alberto, founder of CDEM.

Juan Rivas (known to most as Alberto) was born in Moca, DR. At the age of 12, he left a difficult home situation to work in the home of a Seventh Day Adventist family. There, at the age of 16, he taught himself to read so he could read the Bible. He also began attending school for the first time that same year. At the age of 20, Alberto became a Christian following his very first visit to a Christian church in Santiago led by Ramon Gabriel. Alberto went on to train for ministry in Panama and also at Colegio Biblico in Texas.

After preaching with medical clinics for several years, Alberto felt called to plant a church in Monte Cristi. He traveled to Monte Cristi for over a year to lead Bible studies, and then in 2002 he moved there with his family. In 2004, he planted a second church in Madre, a nearby village.
